Deer Recovery List Sign Up and Procedures:

FRISC coordinates with the RIDEM in providing a deer recovery list for deer killed by vehicles. In the past clubs would provide a list of members to recover deer in the town and surrounding areas near their clubs.

As of 2017, the deer list has changed. Police dispatchers are unable to dedicate the time to administer a phone tree. FRISC will now provide 2-3 contacts per club to the dispatchers. These individuals will take on the role of coordinators. The dispatchers will contact them for deer recovery. These coordinators may recover the deer themselves or contact other club members to do so. Once an available member agrees to make the recovery, the police will be notified who will make the recovery. Club coordinators are encouraged to build "phone trees" in whatever manner is most effective for them: Calls, group texts, private social media groups, etc.
